



The Panhandle Area Educational Consortium (PAEC) is pleased to partner with the Volunteer Florida Foundation/ Florida Family Literacy Initiative in offering the online professional development course, *Research Says! Adult Education and Family Literacy Curricular Integration*. Professional development credit may be awarded for completion of this online course.

Before registering, Florida teachers should contact their district professional development advisor to make sure that the proposed activities meet the needs of the teacher, through their approved individual professional development plan and the needs of the school district as specified in the school improvement plan. Each district has final authority regarding the awarding of inservice points for all professional development activities, and must include them in their Master Inservice Plan. Florida teachers must submit the Course Overview page (from the Web site) prior to registration to their school district professional development offices.

Upon satisfactory completion of course requirements, a certificate verifying completion and stating the recommended number of inservice points may be printed electronically from your personal transcript page within the electronic Professional Development Connections (ePDC) at PAEC. If you wish to earn professional development credit, this certificate must be submitted to the person in your school district that is in charge of awarding professional development points.
