

## Component: Parent and Child Together (PACT) Time

### Objectives: Dialogic Reading

- Ask “what” questions.
- Follow answers with questions.
- Repeat what the child says.
- Expand on what the child says.
- Help the child as needed.
- Praise and encourage the child.
- Follow the child’s interest.

## Grows Family Literacy Program

**Classroom/Space Set-up:** Tables & chairs

**Materials Needed:** Farm animal cut-outs, paper bags, construction paper, scissors, markers, crayons, glue.

**Lesson Set-Up:** After paper bag craft activity, a dialogic reading activity between mother and child will follow. In this activity, mothers will ask “what” questions, follow the child’s interest, praise and encourage the child and follow answers with questions.

### Activities:

1. Paperbag, Farm Animal Hand Puppets
2. Vocabulary: animal names & sounds
3. Reading Session
4. Song: Old MacDonald

## Jump Start Family Literacy Program

**Classroom/Space Set-up:** Tables & chairs

**Materials Needed:** Paper, hole punch, yarn, song sheets, animal pictures, animal sound block, color chart, “Buzz Said the Bee,” “Spot’s At the Farm”

**Lesson Set-Up:** Welcome, Parent Lacing Animals Craft, “Buzz Said the Bee” review, “Good Morning” song

### Activities:

1. Lacing animals
2. Vocabulary: animal names & sounds
3. Color review (yellow)
4. Songs: Buzzing Bees, Hear the Bee, My Bee, Cows in the Barn, Fluffy Sheep
5. Book review

**Lesson Wrap-Up and Debriefing:** Transition into adult and child centers.
